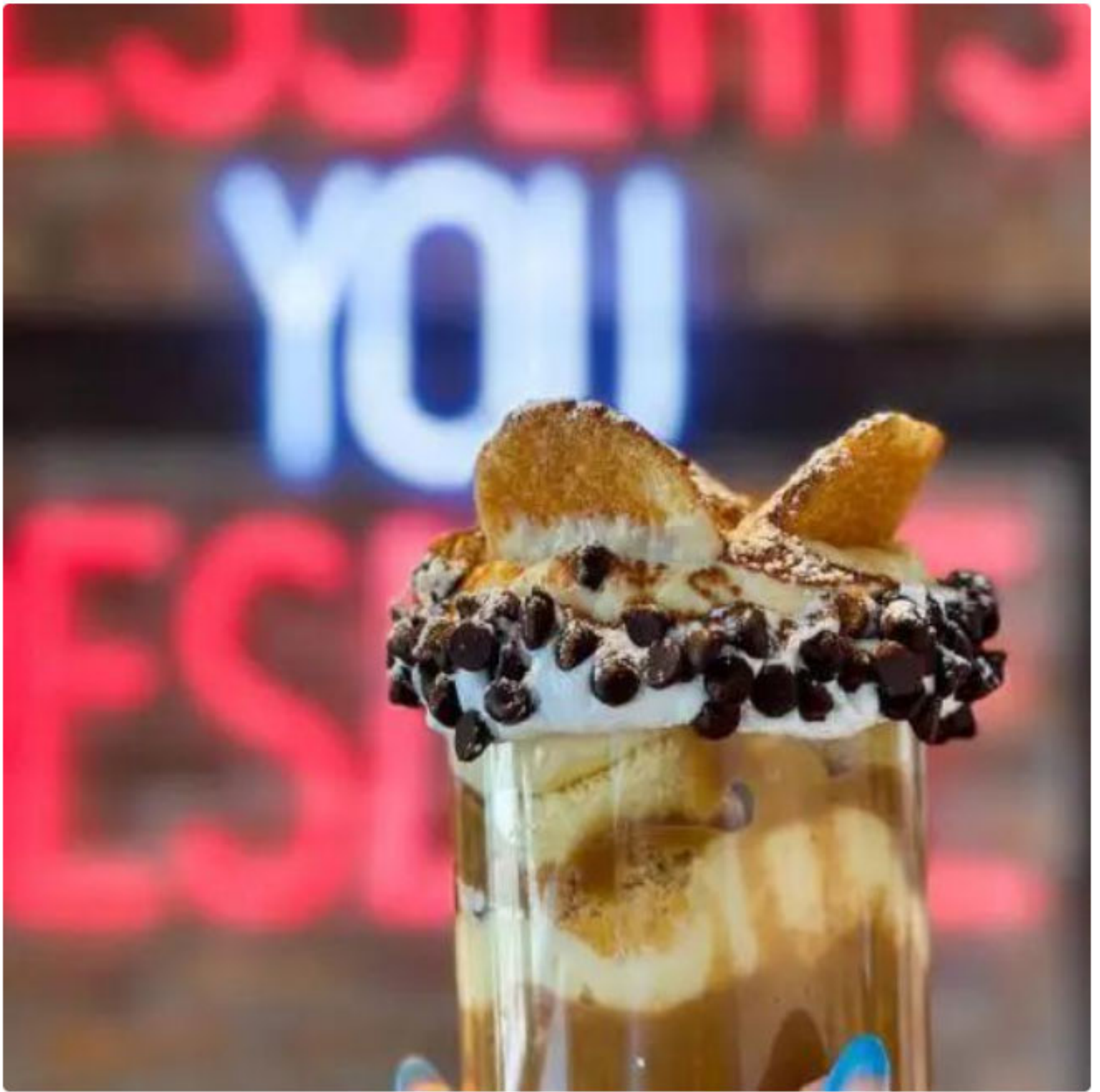

Franchisees **Jason** and **Tejal Wible**, who also own and operate Dogtopia, are bringing the concept to Fort Worth. JARS currently has locations in operation in Illinois and California.
