'Top Chef' star opening dessert shop in Fort Worth

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A dessert shop from *Top Chef* contestant Fabio Viviani is coming to Fort Worth.

JARS, where classic desserts like cheesecake and apple pie are layered into single-serve jars, will open Jan. 19, 2024, on South Hulen Street. It'll be near Le Margot, a <u>restaurant from another celebrity chef — Graham Elliott</u> — that opened last year.

Viviani opened the first JARS in 2022 in Chicago and later opened another location in California. The new Fort Worth location is the first of nearly a dozen planned for Dallas-Fort Worth, according to a release. JARS' website lists Dallas, Highland Park, Plano and Frisco as markets where it will open soon.

Mud pie, tiramisu, strawberry shortcake, red velvet cheesecake and pumpkin pie are a few of the jarred desserts on the menu. Some flavors like cherry pie and cannoli rotate on and off.

The desserts, which "refuse to conform to a space filled with cookies, cupcakes and copycats," are layered into jars akin to mini trifles and topped with all manner of cookies, crumbles, fruit and sprinkles.
